# What is the LCAP?

---

... all Local Education Agencies (i.e. DMUSD) are required to prepare an LCAP, which describes how they intend to meet annual goals for all pupils, with specific activities to address state and local priorities identified pursuant to *EC* Section 52060(d).

# Proposed LCAP actions were developed through:

- Analysis of state and local assessments and local indicator data
- Observational data from school visits by site and district leadership
- Parent, staff, and student input and feedback via surveys, focus groups, and district committees
- Strategic Planning
- Feedback from SDCOE
- Public Hearing and resulting feedback

## LCAP Activities Reflecting Educational Partner Feedback

---

- Increasing social/emotional support for students with an additional counselor
- Continuing of lower class size
- Maintaining support for tier two academic Intervention
- Implementing strategies to support families and students from diverse cultural backgrounds as they transition to DMUSD schools
- Maintaining robust professional learning and ensuring differentiated support and choice for teachers

# LCAP Activities Reflecting Educational Partner Feedback

## -Continued

---

- Continued inclusion of strategies in professional learning in meeting the needs of diverse learners, including those who are high achieving and those requiring support to meet expectations
- Implement strategies to support teachers in understanding best practices in technology integration (AI, Updated digital Citizenship lessons, district technology leaders)
- An education series to support the social-emotional wellbeing and health of their children and obtain a better understanding of the instructional program
