What is the LCAP?

... all Local Education Agencies (i.e. DMUSD) are required to prepare an <u>LCAP</u>, which describes how they intend to meet annual goals for all pupils, with specific activities to address state and local priorities identified pursuant to *EC* Section 52060(d).

Proposed LCAP actions were developed through:

- Analysis of state and local assessments and local indicator data
- Observational data from school visits by site and district leadership
- Parent, staff, and student input and feedback via surveys, focus groups, and district committees
- Strategic Planning
- Feedback from SDCOE
- Public Hearing and resulting feedback

LCAP Activities Reflecting Educational Partner Feedback

- Increasing social/emotional support for students with an additional counselor
- Continuing of lower class size
- Maintaining support for tier two academic Intervention
- Implementing strategies to support families and students from diverse cultural backgrounds as they transition to DMUSD schools
- Maintaining robust professional learning and ensuring differentiated support and choice for teachers

LCAP Activities Reflecting Educational Partner Feedback -Continued

- Continued inclusion of strategies in professional learning in meeting the needs of diverse learners, including those who are high achieving and those requiring support to meet expectations
- Implement strategies to support teachers in understanding best practices in technology integration (AI, Updated digital Citizenship lessons, district technology leaders)
- An education series to support the social-emotional wellbeing and health of their children and obtain a better understanding of the instructional program
