

# **CHILD FIND**

Child Find is a legal requirement for schools to identify children who have disabilities and need services. Child Find is part of a federal law called the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA). This law protects the rights of students with disabilities.

### CHILD FIND AGES 0 - 5

If you suspect your child has a disability and they are younger than 3 years of age, contact San Diego Regional Center.

If you suspect your child has a disability and they are preschool age (starting at 2 years 10 months), contact the Student Services Department.

# SCHOOL-AGE (K-6)

For school-age children, contact your child's principal. Based on your concerns, your child may be referred to the Student Study Team (SST). At this meeting, your child's progress will be reviewed and interventions and strategies may be recommended to assist your child. The SST process also assists with the development of an assessment plan should there be a suspected disability.
