Parentally Placed Private School Students

Parentally Placed Private School
Students (PPPSS) are school-aged
students (K-I2) with disabilities enrolled
in not-for-profit private schools. IDEA
states that the school district in which a
private school is located is responsible
for locating and assessing students with
disabilities that have been parentally
placed in non-profit private schools.
Child find responsibilities lie with the
district where the private school is
located.

Child Find Services for Private School Student's include:

- Assistance in determining if a private school student may need special education services under federal law.
- Reevaluation of parentally placed private school students previously found eligible for an IEP.
- Offer of a Service Plan with consultative services
