- Ability to open up to the outside
- Lighting inside and outside
- New chairs
- Flexible furnishings
- In floor electrical
- Reconfigure podium - mechanical
- Improve Wi-fi
- All younger students need to see the stage
- Height of stage is too tall
- Need great view of the stage for all audience members
- Stairs on both sides of stage
- Adjustable space, multiple rooms, smaller spaces
- Consult with a stage expert for ideas
- Stage is too deep
- Needs to be large enough to fit entire school population
- Increased , improved audio visual equipments, hanging microphones - hard to hear students when they are performing
- Flooring - consider other material than carpet, but still comfortable for students to sit on
- Kitchenette (sink, oven/stove)
- Additional storage
- Adjust storage under the stage - too deep and so back half is not useable
- Ability to prop doors open
- Replace blinds - style is not good with kids
- Mounted projector
- Keep ceiling
- Staggered curtains on stage
- Improve lighting on stage

## **COMMON LEARNING AREAS**

- Flexible furniture for outdoors - tables, create a space for learning, colorful and cheerful
- Maintain as an alternative space - feel as though it is a place for a break
- Sensory garden for planting and exploring
- More shade over the outdoor spaces for learning
- Backpack storage to create more space for learning outside
- Lines of visibility
- More storage for teachers on campus for teachers - close by
- Courtyard - access to outdoor electrical
- Library - maintain books in the library
- Breezeway - students are climbing trees, which may not be safe, consider alternative activities

to replace - learning activities, sensory tables, hopscotch, replace or remove bushes with berries, need to maintain greenery need to consider upkeep that is necessary

- Space outside classroom - class windows that open up to are, but consider safety/lines if visibility
- Quiet rooms - furniture that facilitates movement
- Comfortable seating - make sure students fit the seating

### **LUNCH AREA AND PLAYGROUNDS**

- Water bottle fillers on campus
- Additional shade on the playground and lunch area
- Water fountains get really hot
- More opportunities for students other than playing with balls
- Seating around the field for weekend use
- Better drainage
- Field unbalanced
- Access to lower basketball court for younger students
- More permanent shades
- Lunch tables for rain or shine
- Expand shade in facilities master plan schematic to ensure full coverage
- Field needs to be improved - consider irrigation improvements, fix holes in grass
- Considered adding swings to school playground
- Add sandbox to grades other than K - kids love to dig at all ages
- Add a track
- Exterior lighting on weekends/nights for community not just for school events
- Lunch distribution facility - friendly service
- Primary lunch tables are difficult to write on because of grids, consider replacing
- Shade structure over lunch area - water resistant so they can be used during light rain or consider roof for coverage
- Front of school - replace dead plants, use space in front to expand office/learning spaces, decorate/paint stairs, clearly identify entrance to office and ECDC
- Flexible seating in lunch area to provide option for student need - make it have a community feeling
- Music/sound system in lunch area
