DMUSD provides an arts education program that includes credentialed art teachers, music teachers, and integration technologists. “Arts education program” includes, but is not limited to, instruction and training, supplies, materials, and arts educational partnership programs, for instruction in: dance, media arts, music, theatre, and visual arts, including folk art, painting, sculpture, photography, and craft arts, creative expressions, including graphic arts and design, computer coding, animation, music composition and ensembles, and script writing, costume design, film, and video. Teachers in these positions see students in Kindergarten-6th grades inclusive.
